



**CLASS OF 1945 SCHOLARSHIP
CRITERIA FOR APPLICANTS**

1. Class of 1945 Scholarship is worth \$500.00. This amount is to be given each year until money is gone.
2. Alliance seniors planning to attend either college or vocational school are encouraged to apply.
3. Application deadline is **March 15, 2010**, to Mr. Carlson, Alliance High School.
4. The selection committee shall be the high school honors committee. The AHS counselor will serve as advisor to the committee.
5. Upon selection, the recipient will receive official written notification from the Scholarship committee. One half of the scholarship (\$250) will be paid when a class registration and schedule is provided as proof of attendance. Send this information to the APS Foundation Director, 1604 Sweetwater, Alliance, NE 69301.
The second half of the scholarship (\$250) will be paid upon receiving a copy of the recipient's registration for the second semester and grades of 2.0 or higher for the first semester. In order to receive payment, the recipient must be enrolled as a full-time student (as designated by the college he/she attends). It is the responsibility of the recipient, prior to leaving to college for the first and second semester, to contact the Foundation Director for the scholarship money. The scholarship check will be made out to the school.
6. An alternate for the scholarship will be selected by the committee.
7. It is required of the recipient to write a thank you to the Class of 1945 for the scholarship indicating where they will attend school and the field of study. Send in care of : **Mrs. Gretchen Garwood, 207 Northpark Estates, Alliance, NE 69301.**
8. It is required that the application form be typed.
